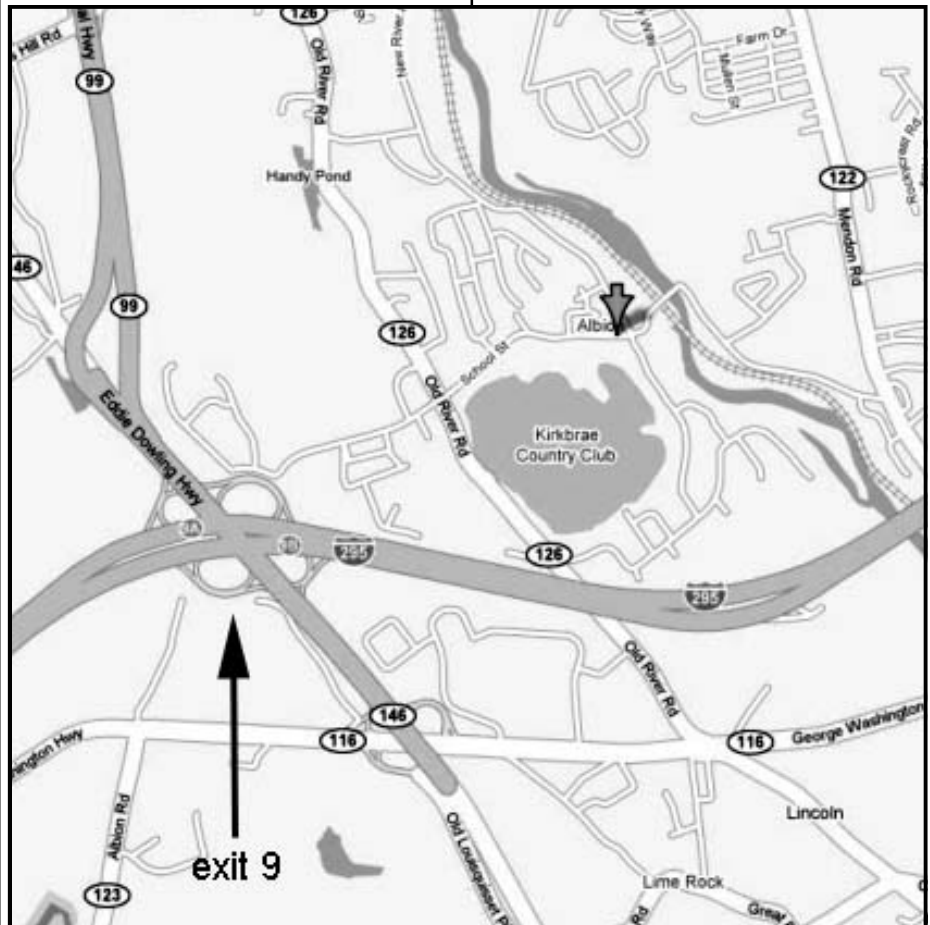
installation of TU members who want to be involved in the organization's work and especially those who can volunteer to serve in an official capacity.

These go nicely with his three hundred dollar hat....Jay has gone to town for this night and will be also be showing us, not only what goes into making the nets, but also his rod cases and his rod building and repair work.
